Amos is survived by his wife and two young children, ages one and four. His sudden passing leaves an immeasurable void in the lives of his family, friends, and all who had the privilege of working alongside him.

At his funeral, friends he had mentored read Michael Josephson's "What Will Matter"—a fitting tribute to a man who understood that true success is measured not by what we accumulate, but by what we give and the lives we touch.
